

SUSPICIOUS ACTIONS TOWARDS CHILDREN

Weld County Sheriff's Office received a report around 3:40pm on March 4, 2009 about 3 young females age range between 6 and 10 who had been approached by a male driving a smaller type white pickup truck asking them to get in to help him find his black and white dog. The pickup truck is further described as having black mirrors, black door handles and a gray tool box in the bed of the truck. This occurred in the Idaho Creek subdivision located at CR 3 and Hwy 119, outside of Longmont. Further investigation revealed the male is described as balding, mustache, with a stud piercing in his chin area and having tattoos that cover his arms completely. The incident occurred around 10:30 am. A report from November 2008 has similarities when young females were approached at a bus stop near a park which is two blocks away. Additional patrols are being made in the area.
