### *VEHICULAR HOMICIDE SUSPECT ARRESTED*


Greeley, Colo. – A 30 year old Craig man has been arrested for vehicular homicide.

The Weld County Sheriff's Office Fugitive Unit, the US Marshal's Service, and the Craig Police Department have been working together to apprehend Tyrrell Kochenower on an outstanding vehicular homicide warrant.

The warrant was issued by the Weld County District Court on February 4, 2010. In September of 2007 Kochenower was involved in a motorcycle accident that killed 21 year old Bethany Gibson near Weld County Roads 29 and 74, rural Eaton. The accident was investigated by the Colorado State Patrol.

Investigative techniques revealed Kochenower was most likely in the Craig area. Additional follow up identified a vehicle and location where Kochenower was staying.

Kochenower was arrested this morning by a Craig Police Officer and has been booked into the Moffat County Jail. Vehicular homicide is a class 3 felony; bond has been set at \$100,000.
