2010 MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND DUI ENFORCEMENT

Members of the Weld County DUI Task Force will be conducting sobriety checkpoints and increased patrols at various locations in Weld County during the upcoming Memorial Day Weekend starting Friday, May 28th through Tuesday, June 1st, 2010. Increased sobriety patrols will also be present throughout Weld County during this holiday weekend. Sobriety checkpoints and increased patrols can take place on any given night at any location county-wide. Memorial Weekend kicks off the "100 Days of Heat" statewide DUI crackdown which will continue through Labor Day.

The Weld County DUI Task Force is a multi-jurisdictional Task Force consisting of law enforcement officers from many different participating agencies focused on targeting impaired driving in Weld County.
