
DUI ENFORCEMENT

The law enforcement agencies of the Weld County DUI Task Force will be conducting a sobriety checkpoint in Weld County during the upcoming Fourth of July Weekend starting Friday, July 1st through Tuesday, July 6th, 2010. Increased sobriety saturations and patrols will also be present throughout Weld County during this holiday weekend. Sobriety checkpoints and increased saturation patrols can take place on any given night at any location county-wide. The Weld County DUI Task Force is conducting these operations in conjunction with the "100 Days of Heat" statewide DUI crackdown which runs through Labor Day.

The Weld County DUI Task Force, a multi-jurisdictional Task Force, consists of many different participating law enforcement agencies focused on targeting impaired driving in Weld County.
