### ***US MARSHALS CAPTURE TWO OF WELD'S MOST WANTED***



The US Marshals' Fugitive Location & Apprehension Group (FLAG) in Denver worked with US Marshals in Mesa, Arizona and Oregon to capture two fugitives featured on Weld's Most Wanted.

Eric Lanzieri has been featured on Weld's Most Wanted since April of 2007 for an outstanding warrant on introduction of contraband issued in 2001. The Weld County Sheriff's Office fugitive unit contacted FLAG and notified them Lanzieri was wanted and was possibly in Arizona. FLAG was able to develop specific location information and sent the case to deputies in Arizona. On November 7, deputies were able to locate Lanzieri and take him into custody without incident at a residence in Mesa, Arizona.

Pablo Rodriguez was featured on Weld's Most Wanted from April through September 2007 for an outstanding parole warrant. The sheriff's office fugitive unit contacted FLAG when they developed information Rodriguez was living in Oregon. FLAG determined a specific location and sent the case to deputies in Oregon. On November 13, deputies located and arrested Rodriguez.

Anyone with an outstanding warrant is encouraged to contact the court for a new court date or turn themselves in to law enforcement. The Weld County Sheriff's Office will continue to aggressively pursue those with warrants who are on Weld's Most Wanted or have been featured on the list in the past.
