SUSPICIOUS INCIDENTS IN SOUTH WELD COUNTY


Greeley, Colo. – Around 4:00 pm today Weld County Sheriff's Office received a call of two men in a dark blue four door car with tinted windows near Hoff Elementary School in Keenesburg. The passenger rolled down the window and told two females, ages 16 and 17 to get in the car. The females did not enter the vehicle and left the area. The victims thought the vehicle might be from the immediate area as they said it looked familiar.

Later at approximately 5:41 pm a call was received about a dark color car that attempted to entice a male and female juvenile into the vehicle, ages 10 and 5.

Due to the similarity in these incidents the Weld County Sheriff's Office is looking for any information on this vehicle or the occupants.

The vehicle in the first incident was described as a dark blue 4 door car with tinted windows. The car could possibly be a Chevy Caprice and built in the late 80's or early 90's. One of the rear tires is smaller and appears to be a "spare" or "donut" style tire. The vehicle in the second incident was described as a dark colored car. The first occupant is described as a Hispanic male with a moustache, wearing a red shirt and the second occupant is described as a Hispanic male with a light complexion or a white male.
