P R E S S R E L E A S E

On Thursday November 17th at approximately 2:30 p.m. an elderly gentleman by the name of Walter Nygren who suffers from early stage Alzheimer's left his residence in the family pickup and is presumed to be lost at this time. The man is described as being 6'1" tall 165 pounds with grey hair and blue eyes. He was last seen wearing a tan jacket and blue jeans. He also was wearing a baseball cap with an elk on the front. The vehicle that he was seen leaving in is described as 1990 burgundy and silver GMC Sierra pickup with Colorado license plate 446-AUL. He was last seen in the area of Weld County Roads 15 and 42 south of Johnstown. This party has been entered in both state and national computer data bases as being lost. The Weld County Sheriff's Office is requesting the assistance from all local media outlets and the public in locating this person for his safety. We would request that this information be given to the public at the very earliest possible time to aid in locating Mr. Nygren as soon as possible. If any one should locate him they are requested to contact their local police department immediately for his safety, if anyone has seen or has information about Mr. Nygren they are requested to contact Weld County communication center at 970-356-1212.
