
CITIZEN'S ACADEMY TO BE HELD IN SEVERANCE

The Weld County Sheriff's Office will be hosting a Citizens Academy starting September 2nd, 2010 at the Severance Town Hall at 336 1st Street, Severance, CO 80546. The Weld County Sheriff's Office Citizen's Academy is a community oriented policing program designed for citizens of Weld County. The academy is conducted at least once a year to accomplish the following goals:
