SEXUALLY VIOLENT PREDATOR COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

GREELEY, Colo. – The Weld County Sheriff’s Office will host a public meeting to provide relevant information and answer questions about a sexually violent predator being released into the Lucerne / Weld County community. Information presented at this meeting will also be made available on the Weld County Sheriff’s Office website following the meeting. Due to the subject matter of the meeting, it is not advisable to bring children. Children under 16 unaccompanied by an adult will not be permitted to attend the meeting. It is strongly encouraged that the appropriate information be shared with children after the meeting.

Local law enforcement has no legal authority to dictate where a sex offender may live. Unless court restrictions exist, sex offenders are free to live wherever they choose. Sex offenders are required by law to notify law enforcement of their residence and law enforcement is authorized to share that information with members of their communities. In the case of sexually violent predators, law enforcement is required to notify members of the community of the offender’s address. Should the offender move to a different address after the initial public notification meeting, updates will be publicized in press releases, and posted on the Weld County Sheriff’s Office website. Identity and photo will be released at the meeting.
