## HOURS VS CREDITS

In the event there is any confusion about hours vs credits. I will make an attempt to clear up some of the confusion. The events that you work are written down at the bottom of the time sheet, those hours are then added together under the respective categories at the top of the time sheet. The number of hours for each line are then multiplied by the value established as a credit for a total of credits earned during the month added up in the outside col-



umn. Credits determine whether you are active, as a minimum # of credits are expected to be earned to remain active. The # of hours then are used to determine the amount of the incentives. Paid events and call in time are counted towards incentives as described on the front of the time sheet. Time sheets are due within 60 days. If there are questions please contact either Poncelow or Martinez.

Volunteers who have donated 200 hours or more attend for a fee of \$1,200 and those without the 200 hrs attend for a fee of \$1,700 which is due and payable in full on the first night of class. ## POSSE MEETING MINUTES

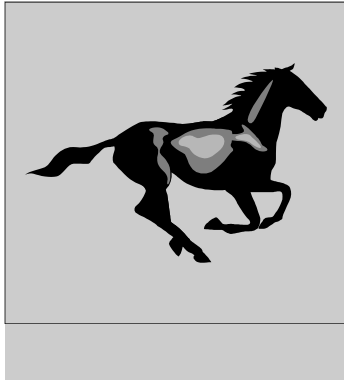
