Always be aware of people on your property or near your residence. The summer months see an increase in people soliciting services in residential areas, but not all of these individuals are representing legitimate businesses. These individuals may be looking for a way inside your home, or may be assessing what type of valuables you have inside your residence. Follow these tips when dealing with any unfamiliar individuals on your property. If you have any issues, notify law enforcement officials immediately.

Ask for identification

Ask for a business card

Do not let anyone in your home that you do not know

If someone you do not know comes to your door, keep your screen door closed

Keep your doors and windows locked EVEN WHEN YOU ARE HOME

Do not let anyone you do not know inside your home for any reason (to use the bathroom, get a drink of water, use the phone, etc.)

Do not let anyone into your home who is not able to identify themselves

Post signage such as 'No Trespass', or 'No Soliciting'

Always get a description of the individual

Always get a description of a vehicle if one is involved

If possible, get a license plate number

Do not engage them if you feel they may be a threat

Do not doubt your observations; if it looks strange, report it

Report ALL suspicious activity to enforcement IMMEDIATELY.
