Drugs found on inmate during booking process

On December 7, 2017, at approximately 7:38pm, the Weld County Sheriff's Office responded to the Weld County Jail, on a report of narcotics being found on female inmate that was recently booked in to the jail.

When deputies arrived on scene, they learned Nadine Helen Caldera (DOB 02/27/1976) was found with a large amount of narcotics during the booking process. A female detention deputy observed what appeared to be a baggie hidden on her person during an intake search.

Deputies found what appeared to be multiple smaller baggies with a white crystal-like substance, as well as a white powdery substance. The substances were tested with a Narcotic Identification Kit. The test came back presumptive positive for meth with a net weight of 51.8 grams and approximately 1.7 grams of cocaine.

Also mixed into the same baggie containing the cocaine was multiple different types of pills.

The pills in the baggie were later identified as:

2 pills of Oxycontin

4 pills of Oxycodone

1 pill of Cyclobenzaprine

2 pills of Tramadol

4 pills of Xanax

5 unknown pills



Caldera is being charged with;

Unlawful Distribution 18-18-405 (Felony 2) for the quantities of meth separated between approximately seven individual baggies.

Possession of Schedule two Narcotics 18-18-403.5 (Drug Felony 4) for possessing meth, Cocaine, Oxycontin, and Oxycodone.

Possession of Schedule four Narcotics 18-18-403.5 (Drug Felony 4) for possessing Xanax.
