Oil Site Incident

On December 22, 2017, at approximately 8:46 pm, the Weld County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to an oil site fire in the area of HWY 392 and Weld County Road 21, near Windsor, Colorado.

When deputies arrived on scene, they found that the site was on fire and 1 worker was injured as a result of the incident. The patient has been taken to a nearby hospital. The condition of the patient is unknown at this time.

Preliminary information suggest that this was an industrial accident, and the scene is being turned over to Windsor Fire for further investigation.
