Public Assistance Request

On the afternoon of January 27, 2017, two suspects broke into a residence in the 9000 block of WCR 22 taking numerous items. The suspects were seen on video, wearing masks and gloves.

The Weld County Sheriff's Office is currently looking for Jonathan Michael Johnson (9/9/96) who is suspected to be one of the individuals involved in the burglary. Johnson also currently has an active nationwide arrest warrant.

On January 30, 2017, around 1500 hours, Johnson was seen leaving a gas station in Brighton in a red, late model Pontiac with two other passengers. They were last seen heading northbound on Highway 85, near the Fort Lupton area. The Weld County Sheriff's Office believes that Johnson may be going to Nebraska. Johnson may be armed and dangerous and is a known user of heroin and methamphetamine.

The Weld County Sheriff's Office is looking for any information that would lead to the capture of Jonathan Michael Johnson.
