### **Public Assistance Needed**

On September 18, 2017, 08:39 am, the Weld County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to a report of paint balls being shot at the reporting party's vehicle from an SUV, on northbound I-25 and Highway 119, in Unincorporated Weld County, Colorado.

When deputies arrived on scene, they learned that a 58-year-old male was driving northbound on I-25, when a grey full-size Chevrolet Tahoe drove past him and shot paintballs at his vehicle. The victim was able to get this photo of the vehicle.
