### Search Warrant near Platteville

On March 2, 2017, The Weld County Sheriff's Office received information about an excavator that had been stolen out of Loveland. The company that owned the excavator was able to track it by GPS to a property located in the 17000 block of WCR 25 ½ near Platteville. On March 3, 2017, a search warrant was executed at the property, and the excavator was located and returned to its owner.

Edgar Gonzales (07/05/1986) was arrested for possession of a weapon by a previous offender, and is currently being held at the Weld County Jail.

Jesus Barrandey-Quintana (07/11/1975) was arrested on charges of possession of schedule 2 substance, no proof of insurance, violation of restraining order, possession of a weapon by a previous offender, and driving without headlights. He is currently being held at the Weld County Jail.

Jacqueline Gonzales (11-20-1983) was arrested on a warrant for no proof of insurance out of Larimer County, and is currently being held at the Weld County Jail.

This investigation is ongoing; further information regarding the investigation and new criminal charges will be released as it becomes available.

All charges are merely accusations until proven guilty in a court of law.
