Suspect Attempts to Elude Deputy

On April 7, 2017, at approximately 10:00 pm a Weld County Deputy attempted to conduct a traffic stop at the location of Highway 34 West bound at the intersection of 65th avenue in Greeley Colorado. The driver of the vehicle was going 70 mph while the posted speed limit was 55 mph.

The Driver of the vehicle drove south on 65th Ave and made a right turn maintaining the speed of approximately 25 MPH onto 29th St. The driver did not slow down, and turned onto 67th Ave. The driver disregarded multiple traffic control devices, driving through multiple parking lots without due regard for other drivers on the road.

The driver finally stopped the vehicle in the parking lot of La Mariposa at 3055 65th Ave, Greeley Co.

The driver of the vehicle, identified as Bianca Alfaro (DOB 01/28/1991), was driving with a suspended license. Alfaro was charged with Speeding (10-19 over), Attempting to Elude, Driving with a Suspended License and Careless Driving

The owner of the vehicle, Jacqueline Valdez was cited for allowing an unlicensed person to operate her vehicle.
