Traffic Accident

On April 1, 2017 at approximately 4:55 pm, the Weld County Sheriff's Office responded to the 12000 block of WCR 76 near WCR 25 to a report of a traffic accident. Three teenage females driving a side by side ATV had wrecked in a ditch that had water in it. Two occupants of the vehicle were able to get out of the vehicle and the ditch, but the other was unable to exit the vehicle. Fire and EMS units arrived on scene, extricated the patient and began CPR; the patient was transported to MCR and her current condition is unknown. The other two passengers were also transported to MCR, and their injuries are not known at this time.

Colorado State Patrol will be assisting with the investigation of the traffic accident. The direct cause of the accident is unknown at this time, and the Weld County Sheriff's Office is conducting a full investigation of the incident.
